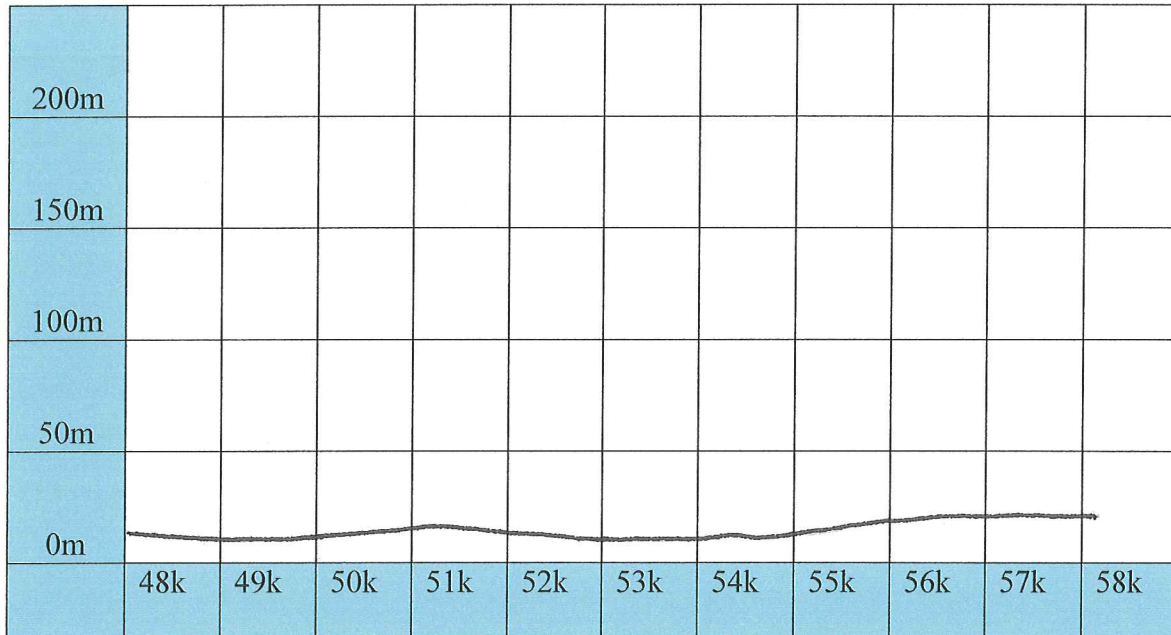


Stage 4 – Basalt Creek to Telegraph Creek – 10.2km



Following the longest stage, this is the shortest stage. The road is flat, and continues to wind along between the river and the railway, crossing Agate Creek at 5km, and Igneous and Log Creeks at 6.5 and 7.7km respectively. The scenery is quite picturesque with impressive views of the river and mountains. There are often a number of waterfalls cascading down the mountains on the left. Again, the shoulder on the right is very narrow in places. The stage ends at the Telegraph Creek rest area, where outhouses are available.
